### Who are the members of the Order of the Eastern Star?

Members of the Order of the Eastern Star are Sisters and Brothers working together to promote Charity, Truth, and Loving Kindness thereby enriching our lives and those around us. #### Did you know?

Dr. Robert Morris, the poet laureate of Freemasonry, founded the Order of the Eastern Star. It was in 1850 while confined to his home following an accident that Morris wrote the initiatory Degrees of the Order. He first initiated his wife and daughters and expanded to some neighbor ladies. The signs and modes of recognition given to them, he freely communicated to Masons so that they would be able to recognize the newly initiated women.

Robert McCoy, who came onboard in 1860, wrote the rituals of the Order. These degrees are centered on the lives of five biblical heroines, Adah, Ruth, Esther, Martha and The Elect Lady with each one representing one of the five principles of the Order, which are Fidelity, Constancy, Loyalty, Faith and Love.

#### What is the Mission of Eastern Star?

To help aid and support the widows, mothers, sisters, wives and daughters of Freemasons. To aid and support members in time of need and to give cheer in their happiness and sympathy in their time of sorrow.

- Women who are majority members of the International Order of the Rainbow for Girls\* or Job's Daughters International\* or have been active for three (3) years, who have reached the age of 18.
- Women who are at least 18 years of age who are sponsored by two Eastern Star members, one Sister and one Brother.

\*and in good standing at the time of their death.

**NOTE:** A female with Masonic affiliation can join Eastern Star even if her Masonic affiliation does not belong to Eastern Star.
